Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon

Since the 1950s, Sonoma County's Alexander Valley has produced world-class Cabernet Sauvignon thanks to its gravelly soils and high daytime temperatures which fully ripen the grapes.

The *Owl Ridge 2013 Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon* is a great example of the region.

Almost floral aromas of cassis, candied fruit and pine abound with a hint of chicory.

On the palate the wine displays rich cacao flavors alongside

pronounced layers of dark berries, Christmas spices, coffee and molasses. The intriguing finish features cranberry, leather and molasses.



The *Owl Ridge 2013 Alexander Valley Cabernet Sauvignon* is drinking well now and will benefit from aging up to five years. We recommend pairing it with dishes such as chicken pasta alfredo, baked ziti and Stilton cheese.
