Dry Creek Valley Zinfandel

Sonoma County's Dry Creek Valley has been one of California's prized Zinfandel-growing regions since the late 1800's. Its well-drained soils and warmer temperatures make it home to many old-growth vineyards producing famously ripe grapes which retain complexity and balance.

The *Owl Ridge 2013 Dry Creek Zinfandel* boasts lush and unabashedly fruit-centered aromas—a real Zin-lover's nose with notes of caramel, dried herbs and raspberry.

The wine is as big and red-berry-focused as you would expect: smooth and full-bodied but balanced with nuanced and almost spicy tannins. Dark coffee layers and butterscotch oak notes, a product of aging in French oak barrels, lead into a long finish of jam, tobacco and cinnamon.



The *Owl Ridge 2013 Dry Creek Zinfandel* is made to be enjoyed now but will age well for the next six years. We suggest drinking it alongside pizza with caramelized onions, barbecued meats and smoked cheeses.
